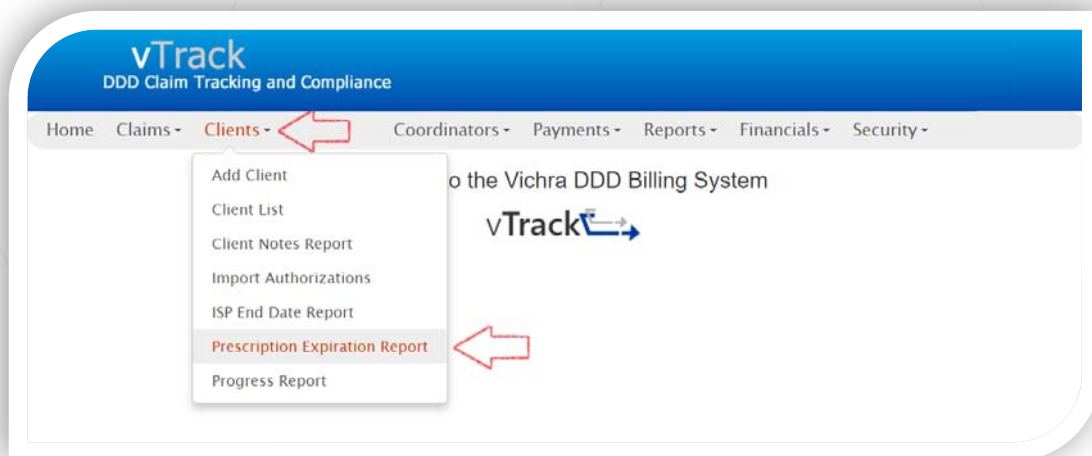



How to Use the Prescription Expiration Report

This report will display a list of client's prescriptions that expire within a specified date range.



1. **Navigate to the Clients Drop-Down Menu**
 - Select-> Prescription Expiration Report



2. **Input Report Date Range**
 - Enter-> Report Start Date
 - Enter-> Report End Date
 - Click-> Submit
